## More Children Qualifying for No Cost Health Care

Did you know that you or your child might qualify for Medi-Cal if he/she is under the age of 19 or you are an expectant mother? Recently, more children with higher family income levels have been qualifying for no-cost Medi-Cal. Children of one or two parent working families may be eligible.

Medi-Cal offers many health care advantages:

- No-cost comprehensive health, dental, and vision benefits for children.
- No monthly premiums.
- No co-payments for any benefit.
- Choice of health insurance plans in most major population centers.
- Family property (such as cars or savings) does NOT count toward eligibility. Convenient mail-in application process.

#### Documents Needed to Apply:

- Proof of Income (pay stub; signed statement from employer; or copy of income tax return).
- Child's birth certificate or proof of immigration status (if pregnant, this is not needed). Proof of California Residency
